

# Elkhart County 10 Year Capital Improvement Plan

Following is a list of projects presented at the Elkhart County Commissioner-Council Summit held on February 3. The projects listed are contemplated for construction, however the plan is just that – a plan for the future. As with any business plan, changes will occur, and so it will be with this plan. It is no surprise that the current economic turmoil has created uncertainties in business and government, thereby making it difficult to plan effectively.

This plan is Elkhart County’s best guess for the next ten years, however it is subject to change, particularly as the plan moves out beyond five years. The first five (5) years projects are typically projects we are currently working or soon will begin working. Engineering design, right of way acquisition, and bidding a project for construction takes three to five (3-5) years to complete, so the first three to five (3-5) years of projects listed are fairly accurate. What may change in the first five (5) years of the plan is listed projects may be delayed because of additional engineering, added right of way, or other similar delays.

The last five (5) years of the plan (2016-2021) are projects that may or may not be constructed, depending upon a number of factors, including but not limited to funding, desire of then elected officials, time capacity of the department to manage such projects, etc. Do not assume that any of the projects listed in the last five years of the plan are commitments to build such projects.

Each year in approximately March, the 10 year plan is updated, adjusted, and posted for public view on this website. The projects listed are only the major projects. Road resurfacing, small bridge repairs and other similar smaller projects are not listed.
